

Pointbench and Scorekeeping using a paper scoresheet form

Before each game

- Check team rosters - player names and numbers, mark possible changes
- Use a free field next to printed number for changed number

Immediately before the game

- Record starting goalies – put their number both to „saves“ box and to „goalie substitution“ box at time 0:0

Game break

- Mark end of period in goal list and penalty list
- Check score with referees/umpires
- Record possible goalie substitution

End of game

- Check score with referees/umpires
- Ask team captains to sign the scoresheet
- Ask referees/umpires to sign the scoresheet

How to record game events

Goal

- Time of goal (minutes:seconds)
- Score after the goal
- Abbreviation of the team (or use H for Home, V/A for Visiting/Away)
- Number of the player who scored
- Number(s) of the player who assisted

Penalty

- Time of penalty (minutes:seconds)
- Abbreviation of the team (or use H for home, V for visiting)
- Number of the player
- Foul name
- Penalty duration (T or 0.5, 1, 2, 3)/card color (Y,R,YR,G)

Faceoff/Draw

- Make a mark for a team which got possession

Shot wide

- Make a mark for any shot which is not goal or save

Save

- Record each save for the goalie (there are 2 lines for 2 goalies)
- Hitting pipe is considered to be a save

Timeout

- Circle period number
- Record a game time of timeout

Goalie substitution

- Record a game time
- Put a new goalie number
